

ADVANCED STANDING APPLICATION

Qualified students may receive Advanced Standing for up to 25% of their master's degree program based on their undergraduate performance. Advanced Standing is not possible for the Master of Arts in Counseling degree. Credit is not awarded for Advanced Standing. Instead, the number of hours required for the degree program is reduced accordingly.

Criteria for Advanced Standing:

- The student must be an admitted degree-seeking student at Midwestern
- The school from which the undergraduate course was taken must be accredited by an accrediting organization recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA)
- The student must have earned a B or higher in the undergraduate course
- The student must have a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0. Failing that, the student must have a GPA of 3.0 in the last 60 hours of study
- The course needs to be equivalent to a Midwestern course that is required for the student's degree program
